The MS AGACNP is a part-time program that incorporates a blend of on-campus and asynchronous online coursework. In general, students will come to campus about 5-6 times per semester. Regarding clinical assignments, we encourage students to participate in the identification of a site prior to their clinical year. If they are unable to identify a preceptor, we will work with the student to make the arrangements.
